CASC specialises in software to meet colleges' needs that are not addressed by or satisfied by commercial products. In addition to our Payment Preparation System (PPS) we have a system that sits alongside it to calculate payments due to Fellows.

Key features

- **Payments csv file**
A payment file with one payment per Fellow that can be imported into your college accounts or payroll package.
- **Payments may include**
Stipend payments calculated from the position(s) held by the Fellow;
Per capita payments uploaded from csv files (e.g. number of interviews, DoS pupils);
Ad-hoc payments manually entered to make adjustments.
- **Stipend advices**
PDF stipend advices for each Fellow showing a detailed breakdown of their payment.
- **Reports**
Reports and filtering available throughout.
